REJECTION

John 1:11 He came to that which was his own, but his own did not receive him.

The heart-rupturing anguish of rejection sprung its sprouts in the early morning of Eternity. Brazenly lifted up in pride, Lucifer turned against the almighty, waging war in the sky seeking to hijack the hierarchy of the Godhead. Consequently, Lucifer along with a third of allegiant angels were cast out of Heaven. Only God knows the cumulative havoc this word rejection has wreaked in this world. The most egregious exhibit and damnable dispiriting display of rejection is the rejection of Lordship and Saviorhood of Christ. The rejection of Jesus Christ is the unpardonable sin that ushers the unrepentant unbeliever to an unending Hell. How bewildering to think that Jesus, the sinless savior, Grace, and Truth perfectly personified, could and would suffer rejection. And yet, we are alerted and astonished, "He came unto his own and his own received him not." Isaiah prophesied the plight of the promised Messiah in Isaiah 53:3, "He was despised and rejected by mankind, a man of suffering, and familiar with pain."

My mother Elizabeth Jones told me as a child, "No matter who you are good or bad, somebody will like you and someone else will dislike you. In childhood naivety, I mythically believed the more I became like Christ the more people would like me. NOT

SO! Christ was crucified not for any wrongdoing He had done, but for the wrongdoers of the world. Wrongdoers may crudely criticize, socially scandalize, and criminally crucify right-doers who have received and replicate the righteousness of Christ.

Life in the Lord over the years has taught me that oftentimes God uses man's rejection to intervene and insert His divine hand of redirection.
